

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Cookies used on our websites

We use the following cookies

`__utma __utmb __utmc __utmz`

These are Google Analytics cookies:

We use Google Analytics to monitor traffic levels, search queries and visits to this website.

These cookies enable Google to determine whether you are a return visitor to the site, and to track the pages that you visit during your session.

Moreover we also use the following cookies:

`__utmz` – stores where a visitor came from (search engine, search keyword, link)

`__utma` – stores each user's amount of visits, and the time of the first visit, the previous visit, and the current visit (presumably partly for double checking of this information).

`__utmb` and `__utmc` – are used to check approximately how long you stay on a site: when a visit starts, and approximately ends (c expires quickly).

At the moment of your first access to the Site and, in any case, until you made a choice, you will be asked to consent to the use of profiling cookies and third party analytics cookies. Particularly, consent may be provided scrolling the Site, closing the banner or clicking on "I Accept".

You may decide to block, erase, deactivate cookies or other similar technology using settings of your browser or device. Each browser (and in some circumstances, each version of the same browser) and each device has a specific procedure to erase or deactivate cookies. Your preferences concerning cookies shall be set separately for each browser or device used, as the functionalities and options offered may vary.
